Do you work?

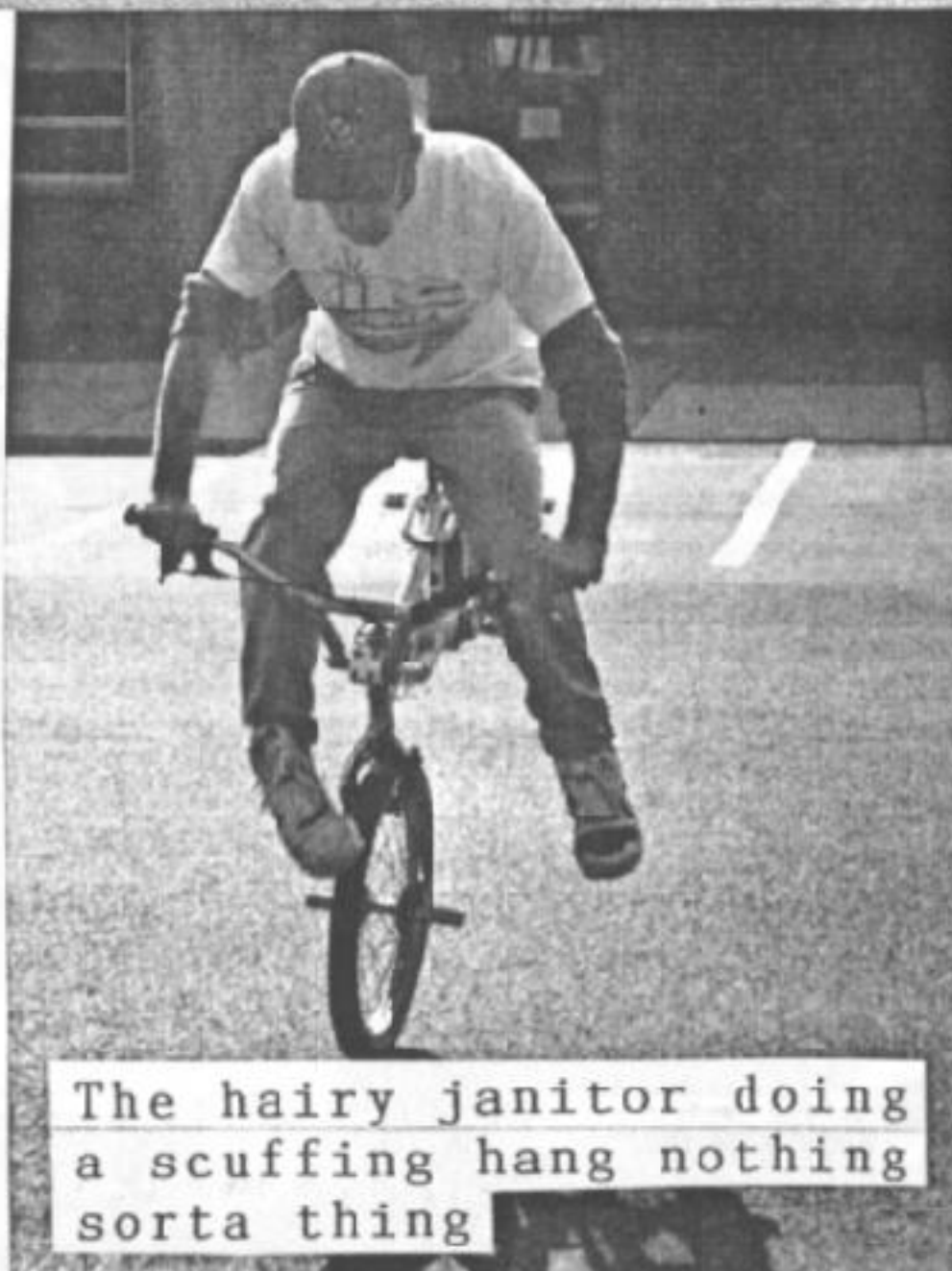
Yeah, at a church near my house. It's cool- I make my own hours. I'm a custodian.

Do you think team Forward Motion has hope or do you not even consider yourself on it anymore, or what?

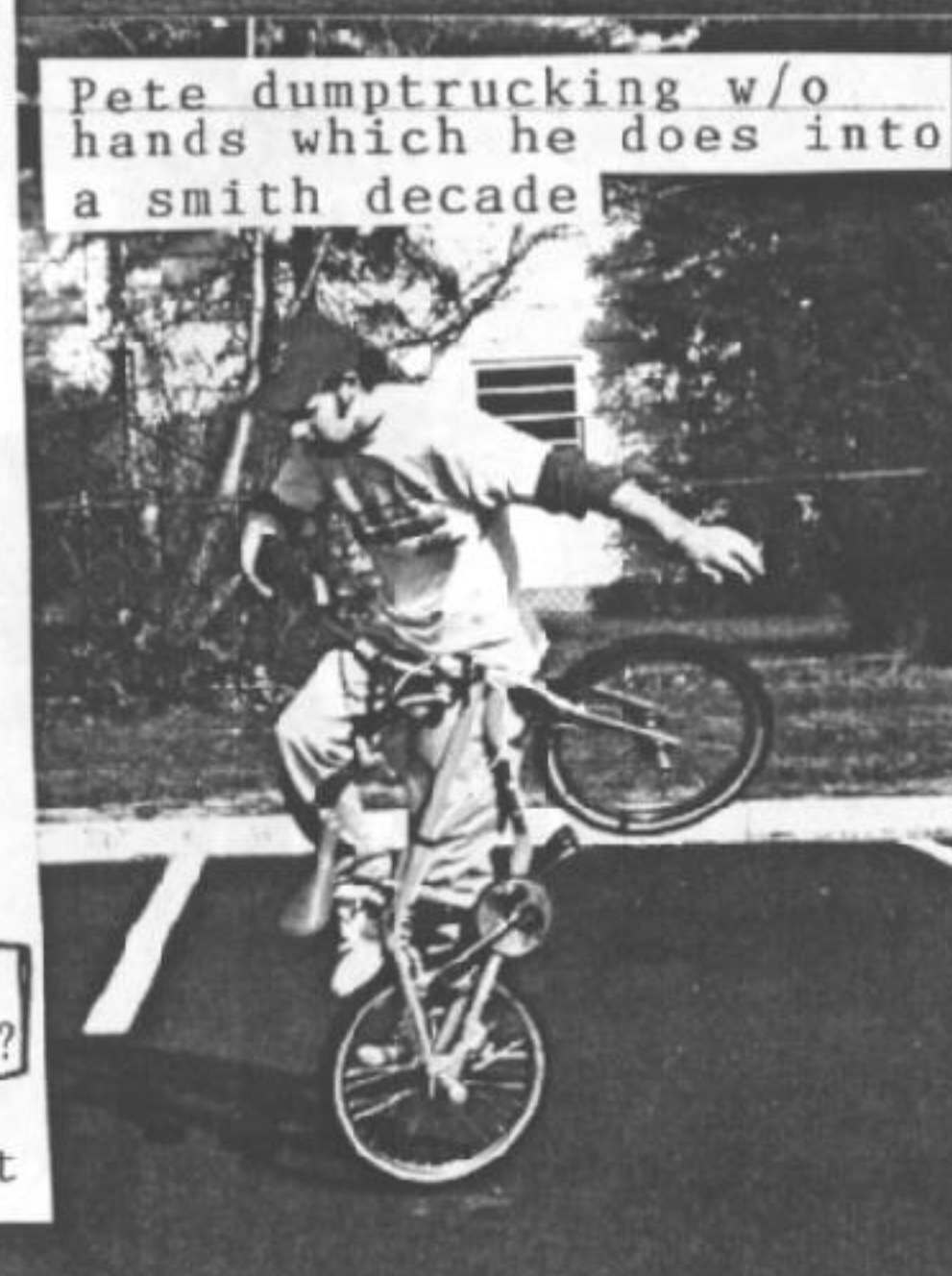

That NJ Freestyle League contest; that

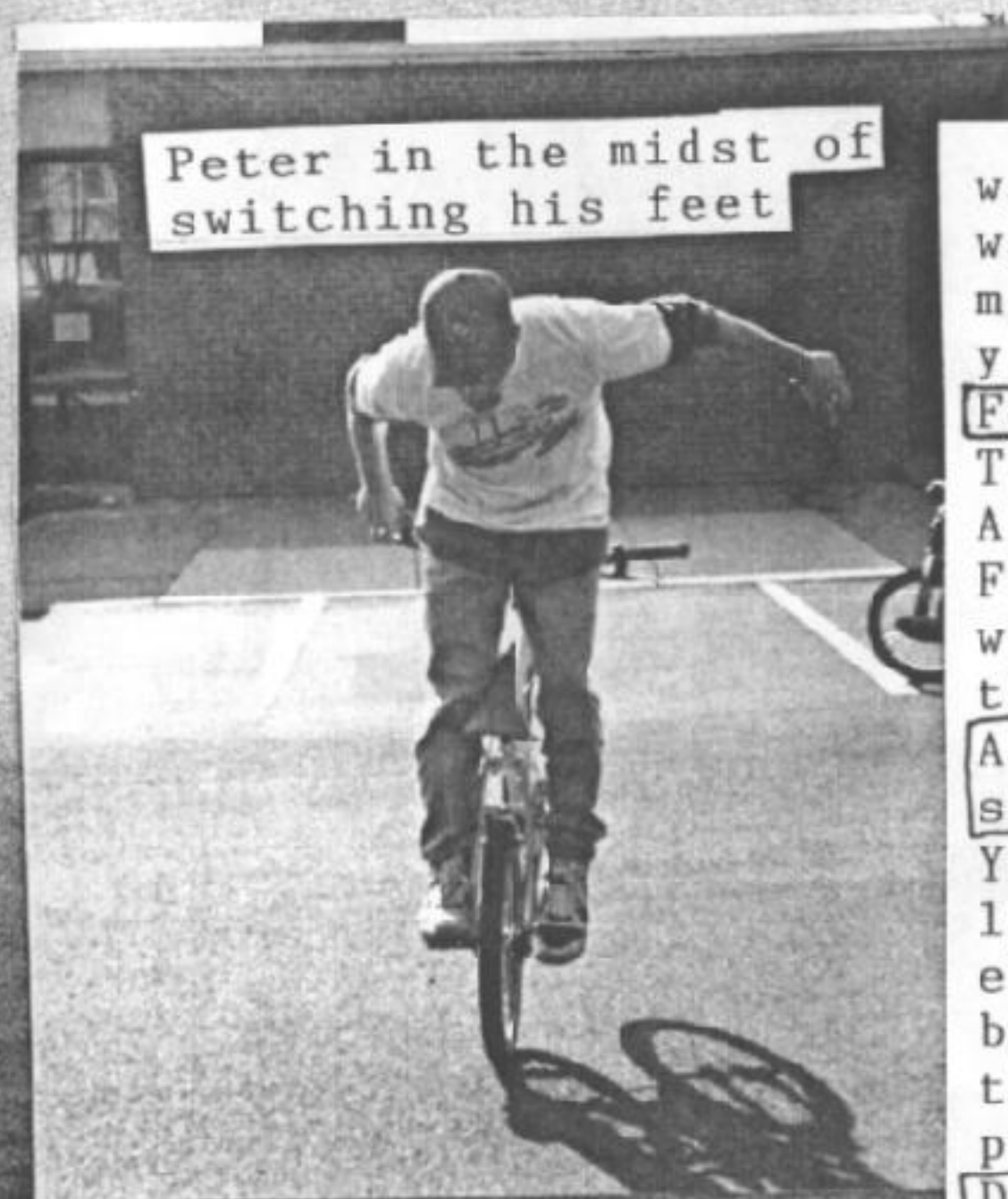

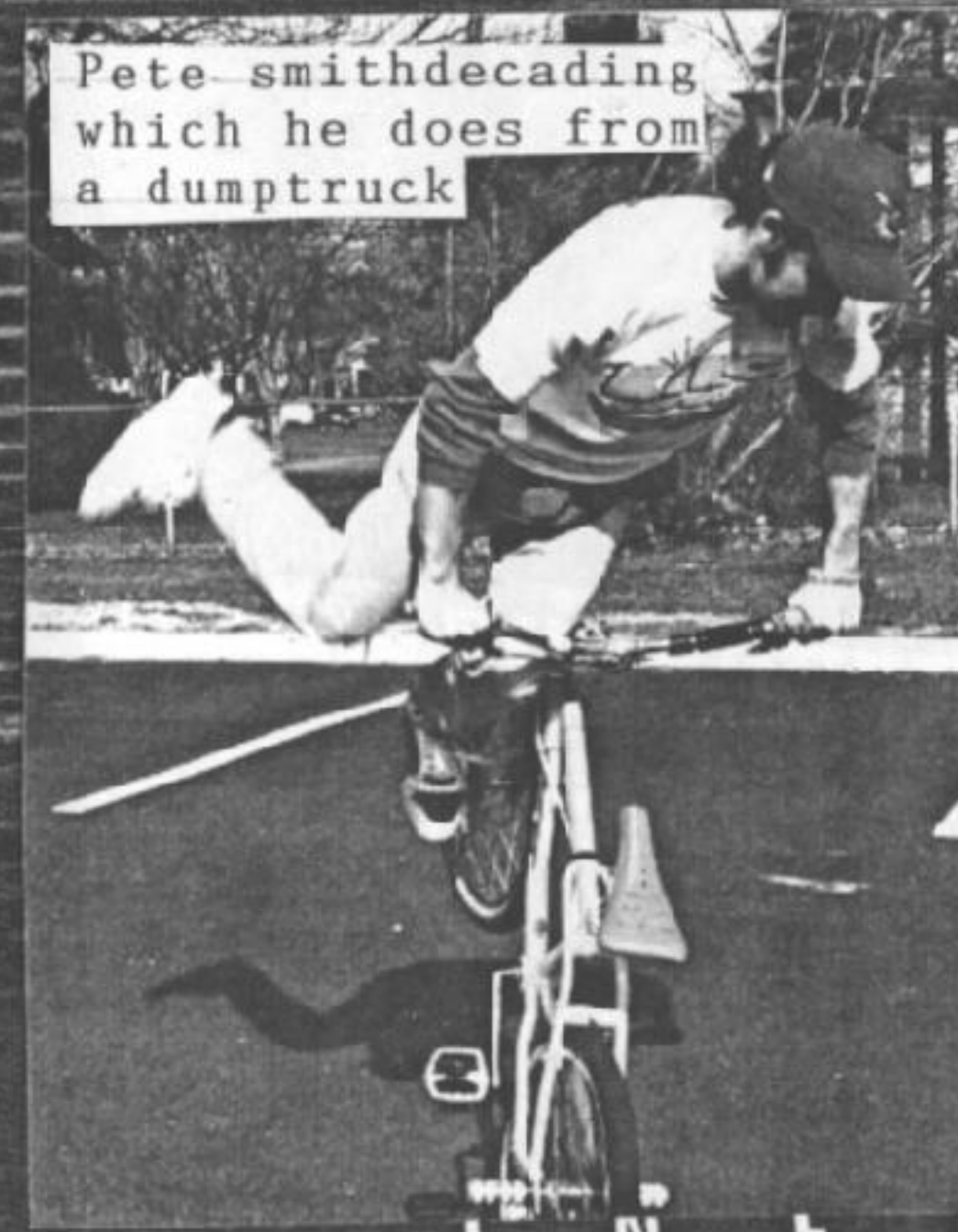


Pete dumptrucking w/o hands which he does into a smith decade

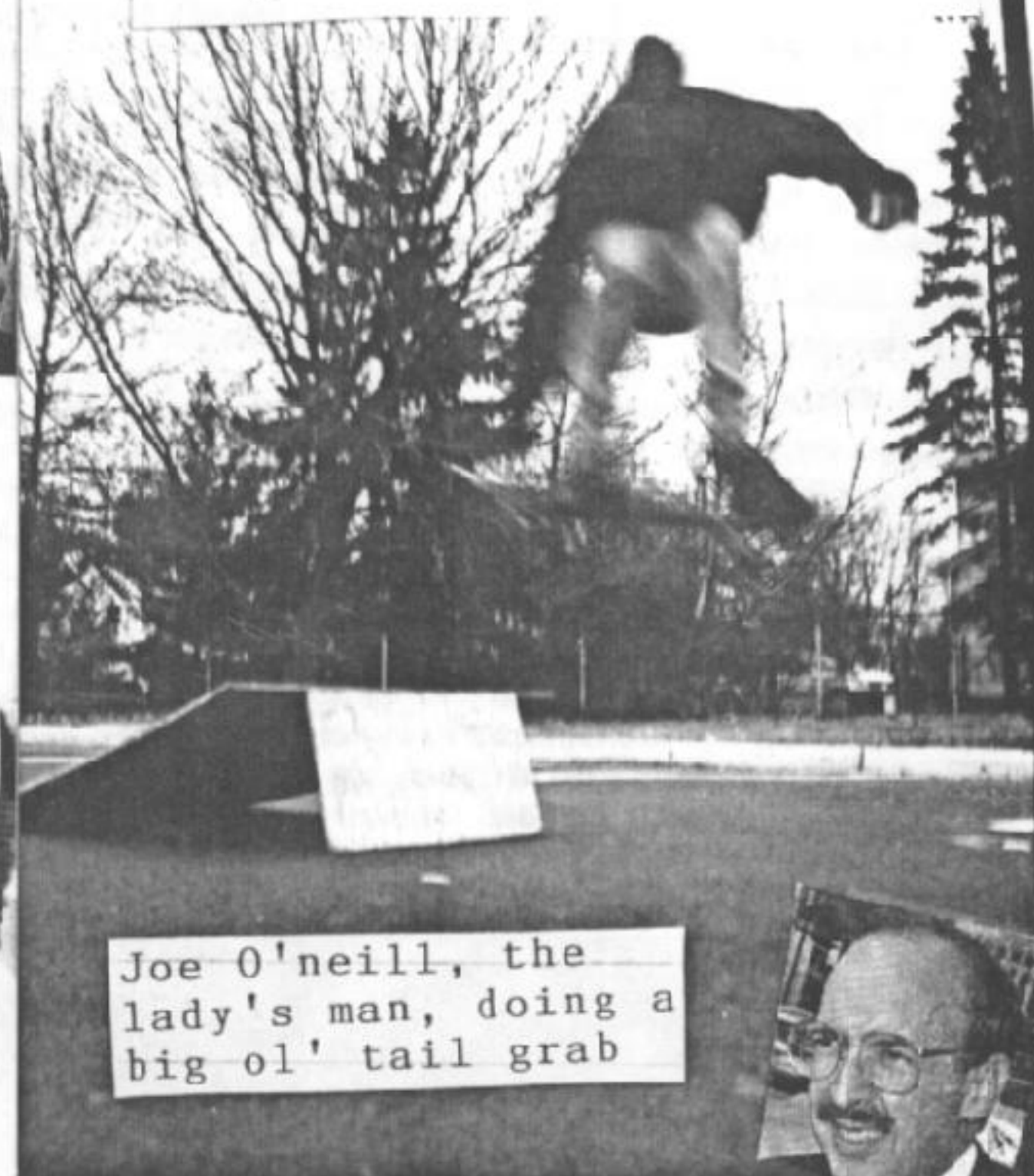

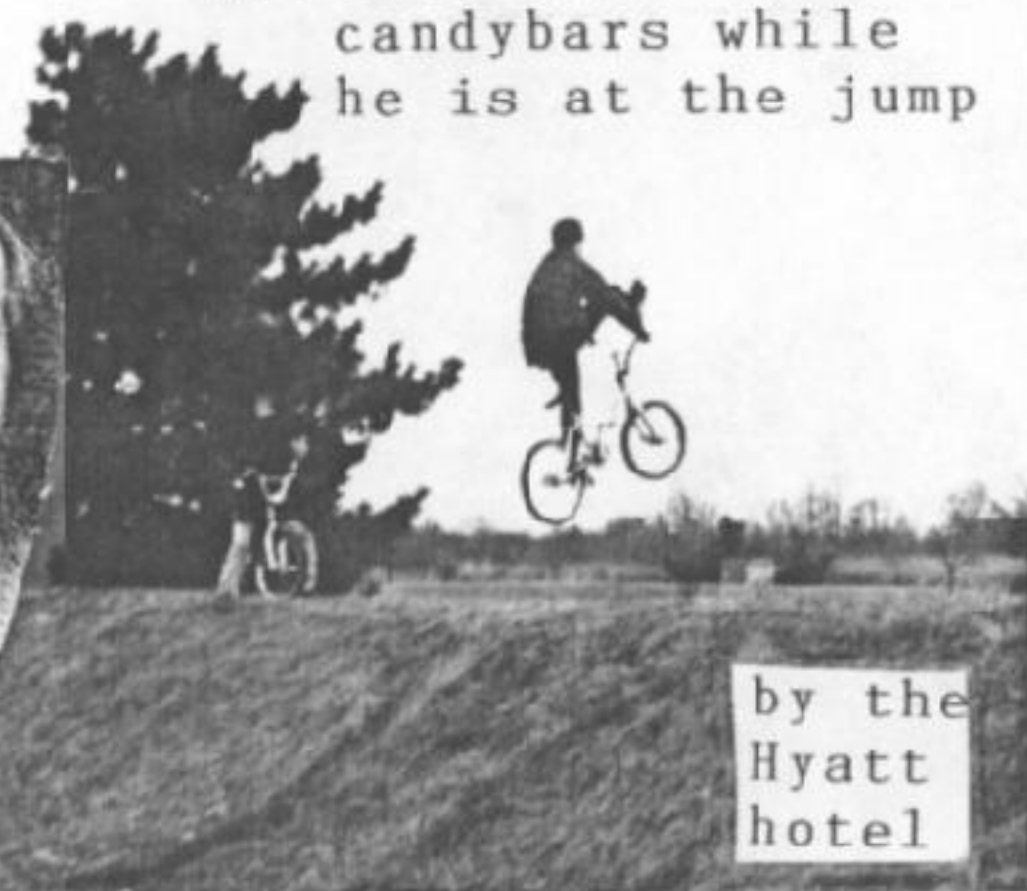

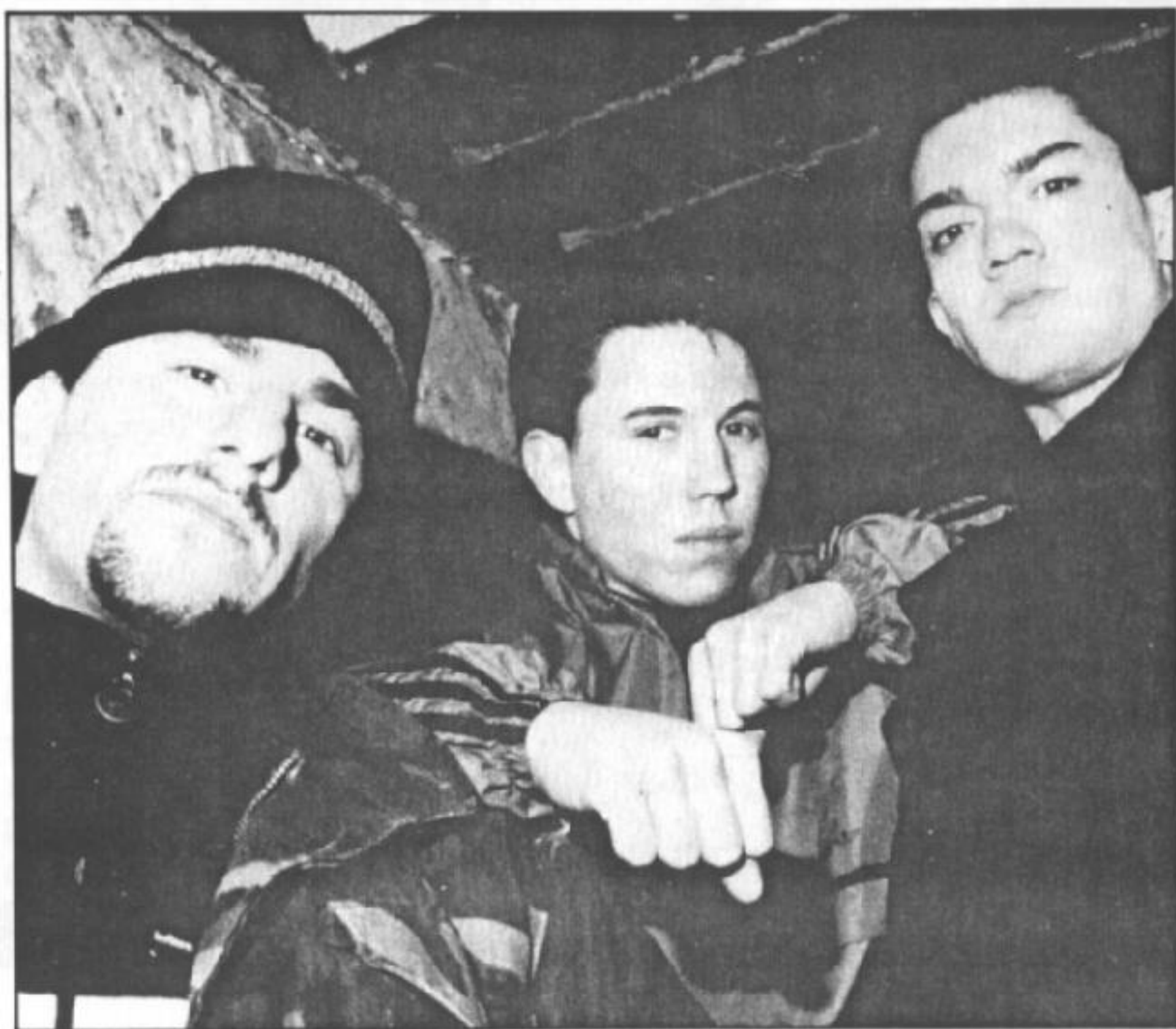

Rest In Pieces Under My Skin Roadracer

This hardcore-hearted debut LP slams its message-packed metal into consciousness with emotion and sweat. As part of the NYC hardcore scene since the band's inception in '84, . . . In Pieces retains the conviction and morality so inherent in true hardcore, yet displays a real groove-ey, metal sound. Guitarist Rob Echeverria (ex-Agnostic Front, Youth of Today and NYC Mayhem), bassist Craig Setari and vocalist Armand Majidi (who sometimes plays drums for Sick Of It All and played drums on this record) really pull together a

tight, vicious and memorable proclamation. As reminiscent in sound of a band like The Jam, as the hardcore that's a part of its past . . . In Pieces has a hard yet hooky, punkish sound. Driven along by the vein-bulging, aggressive, pissed off and not incredibly calculated vocals of Armand, the record displays that this is the position Armand should keep. They're the kind of vocals that can be disputed as off-key, but they're the kind of vocals that seethe with anger—perfect for this band. Every track attempts to open eyes to social and political injustices while ultimately hoping to impart the message, "Let nobody take it, let nobody take away your rights."—*Katherine Ludwig*



The Accused Grinning Like An Undertaker Nastymix

The Accused are one of those few bands that have an overwhelming number of cult fans in both the metal and core factions without being exclusive to either. Hardly trendy, they've kept plodding on through the years with several scintillating releases heavy on splatter and death fetishes with an eye for loads of sick humor.

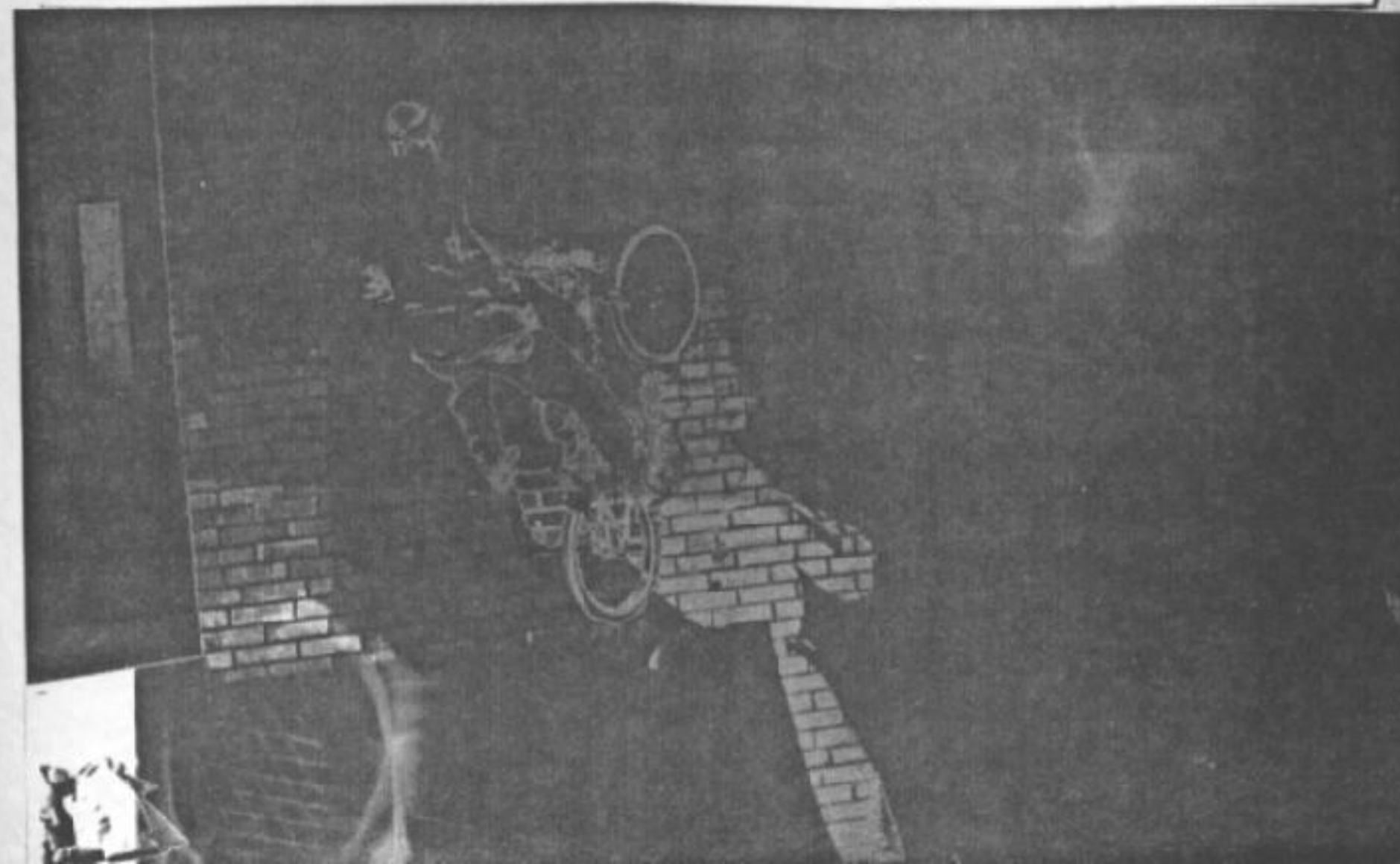
Grinning Like An Undertaker is another traverse through that highly individual sound you can only associate with The Accused. With the label change and the unfounded rumor that vocalist Blaine was contemplating calling it a day, they have reemerged with their best produced and easily best sounding album to date. The down and dirgey vocals of Blaine command the choppy rhythms of each song, as they have in the past, from the stance of an innocent viewing the heady shit in every facet of existence from the dark recesses of your closet to the flaming garbage cans on skid row.



"M Is For Martha" marks another reappearance of mascot Martha Splatterhead, aliterated upon throughout the whole song. The sinister "Voices" is the convoluted paranoid plunge of your average schizophrenic person or victim of society who fears that everyone from the government to dead rock icons is tapping into his unbalanced mind. The music evolves through countless flipped-out time changes in "Pounding Nails," the sheer deafening grind of the guitar sound only enhanced in this track, as in others, by the tremendous synchronicity of the drummer. "Bullet Ridden Bodies" is a shift from the psychotic side of the band to a reality-based vignette of the drug cartel assassinations in Colombia. On nearly every Accused record, there's the prerequisite cover they do. Sometimes they do something befitting, as in interpreting G.B.H., and other times they succeed in bastardizing an old classic - as was once done with Ten Years After. A John Entwistle composition, "Boris The Spider," becomes their target this time, and the Accused manage to pervert it uproariously.

Seattle's renowned sociopaths still have something to say after all these years, probably because they've kept in their own enclave and still refuse to play the game. The Accused are one of those bands that can make you sneer, get crazed and regurgitate all in the same instance - a noteworthy achievement. *Grinning Like An Undertaker* is a bonafide winner with its wrist-slashing music and warped humor.—*Vicky Willis*
