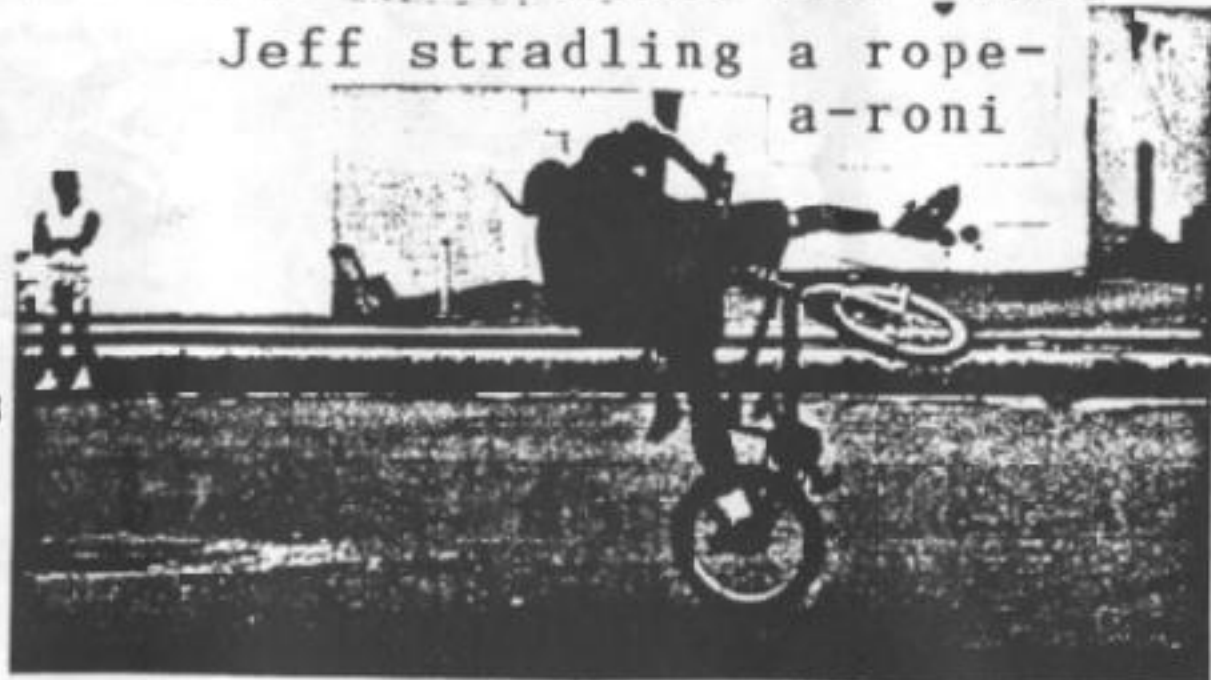
BRITT'S COMP. N.J. FL.

Flatland was better than the first comp, probably because this dude Jeff Crawn was there

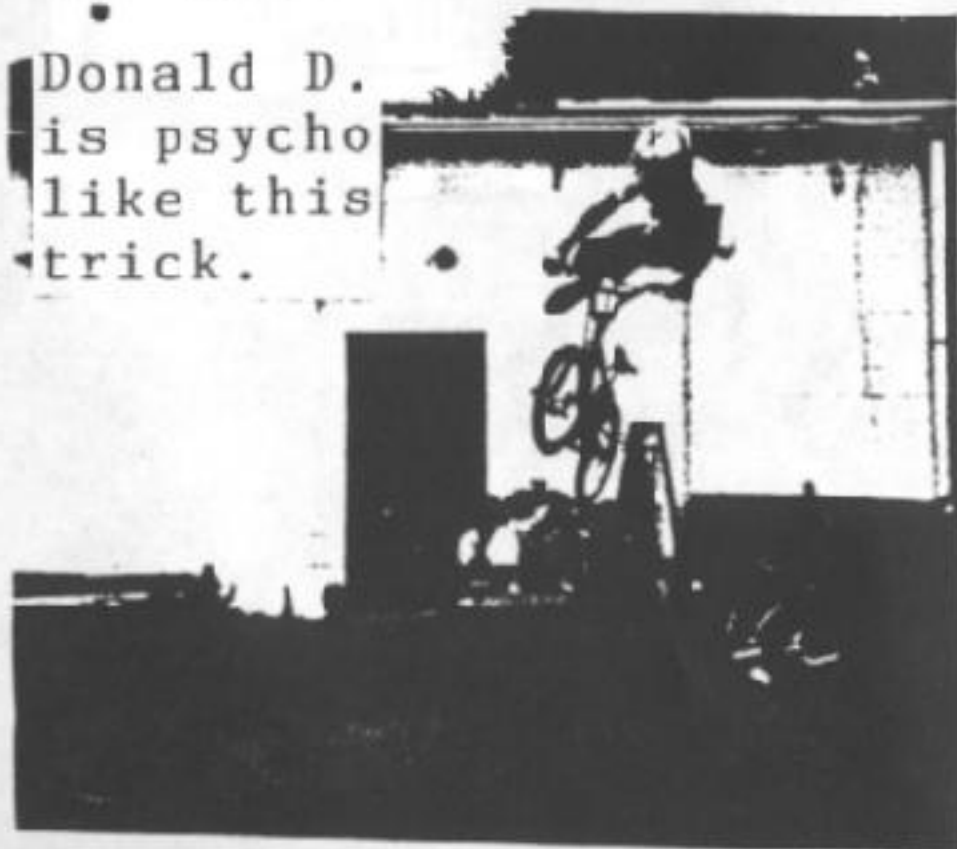
psyching a lot of people out with tricks like rolling overtakers (on the left side) to other tricks like decades and all. He could do every trick, I swear.

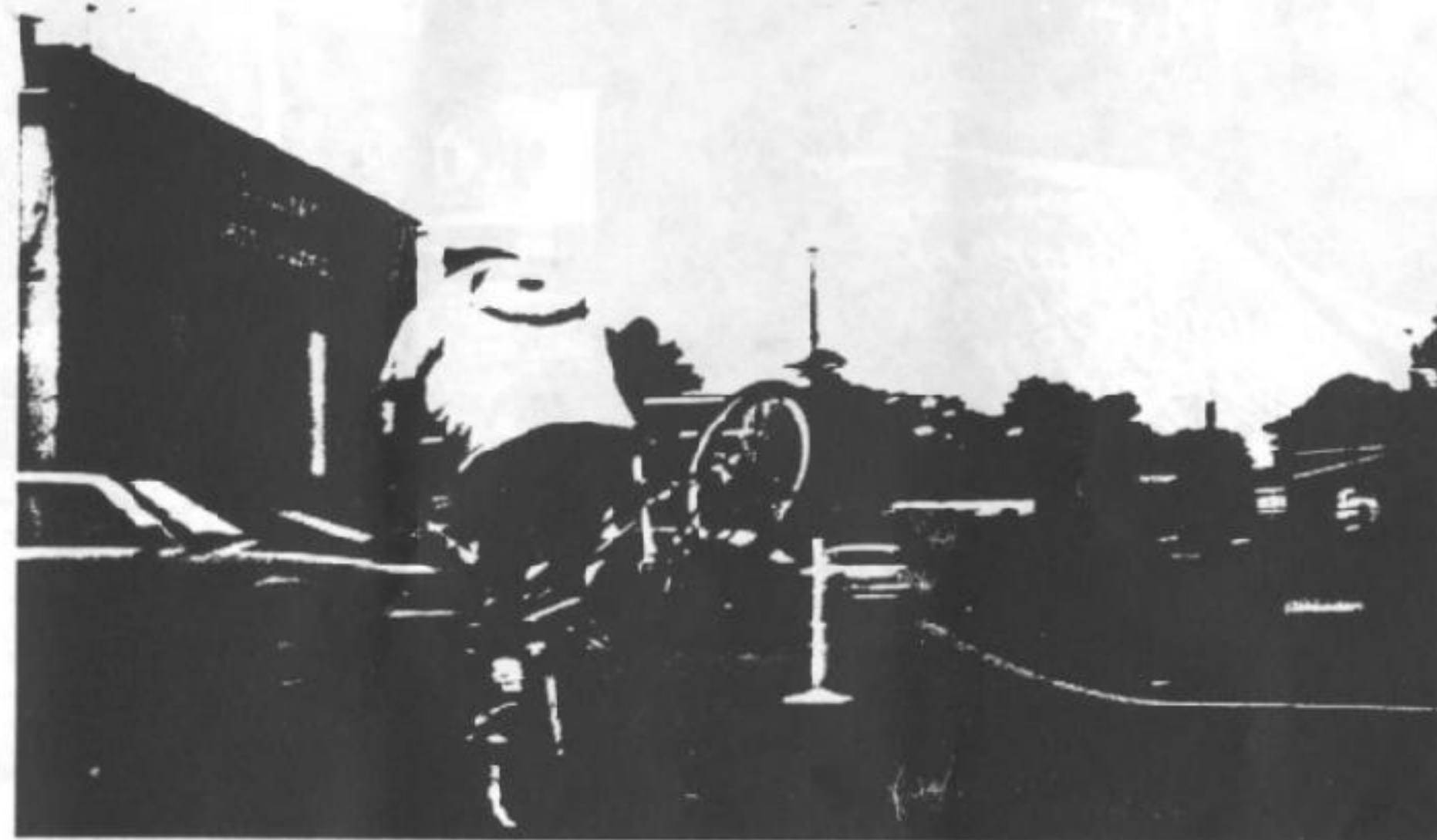

Me and my brother are always looking for new ramps and cool places. It doesn't do much but it keeps us riding and growing in biker life.

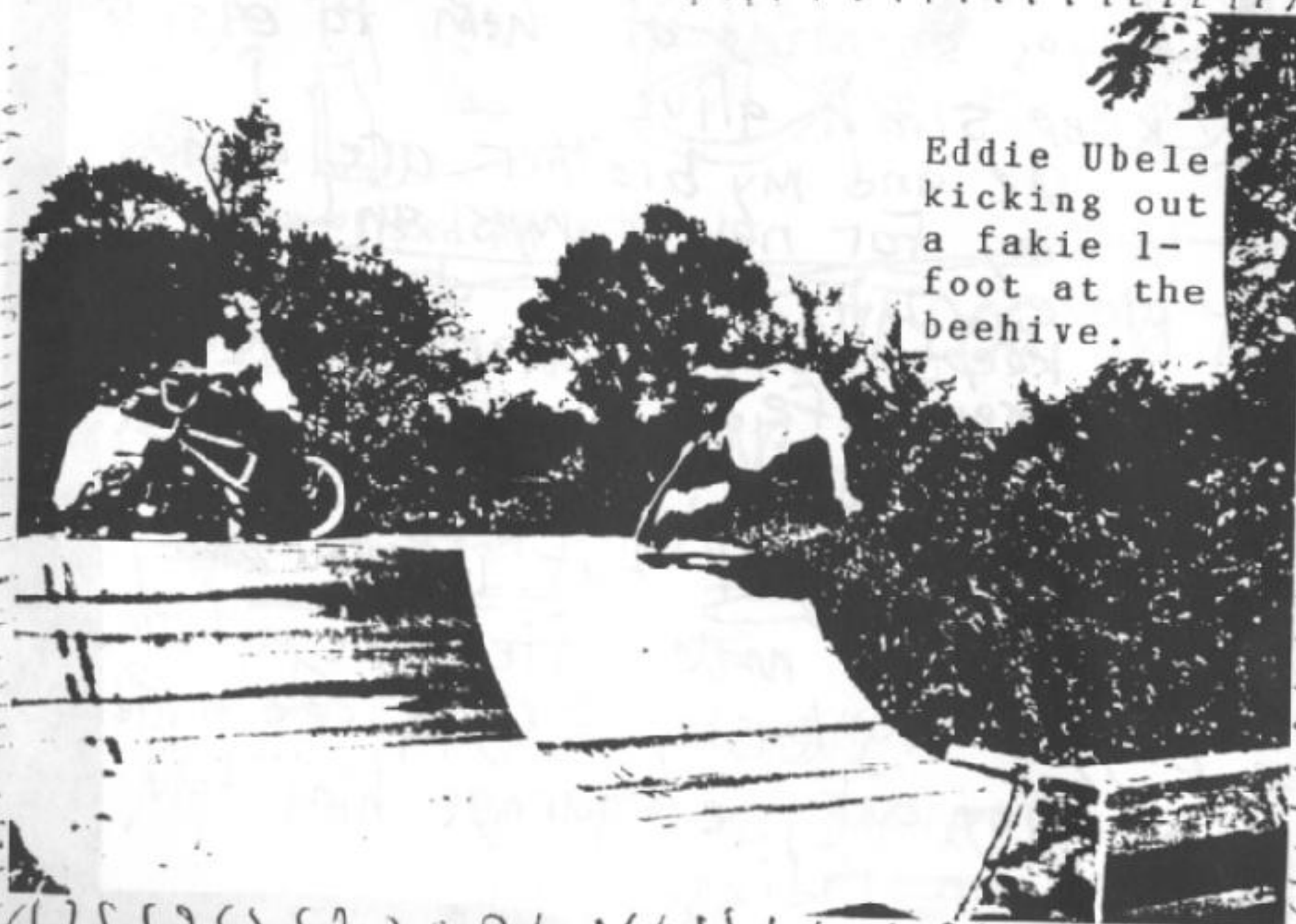

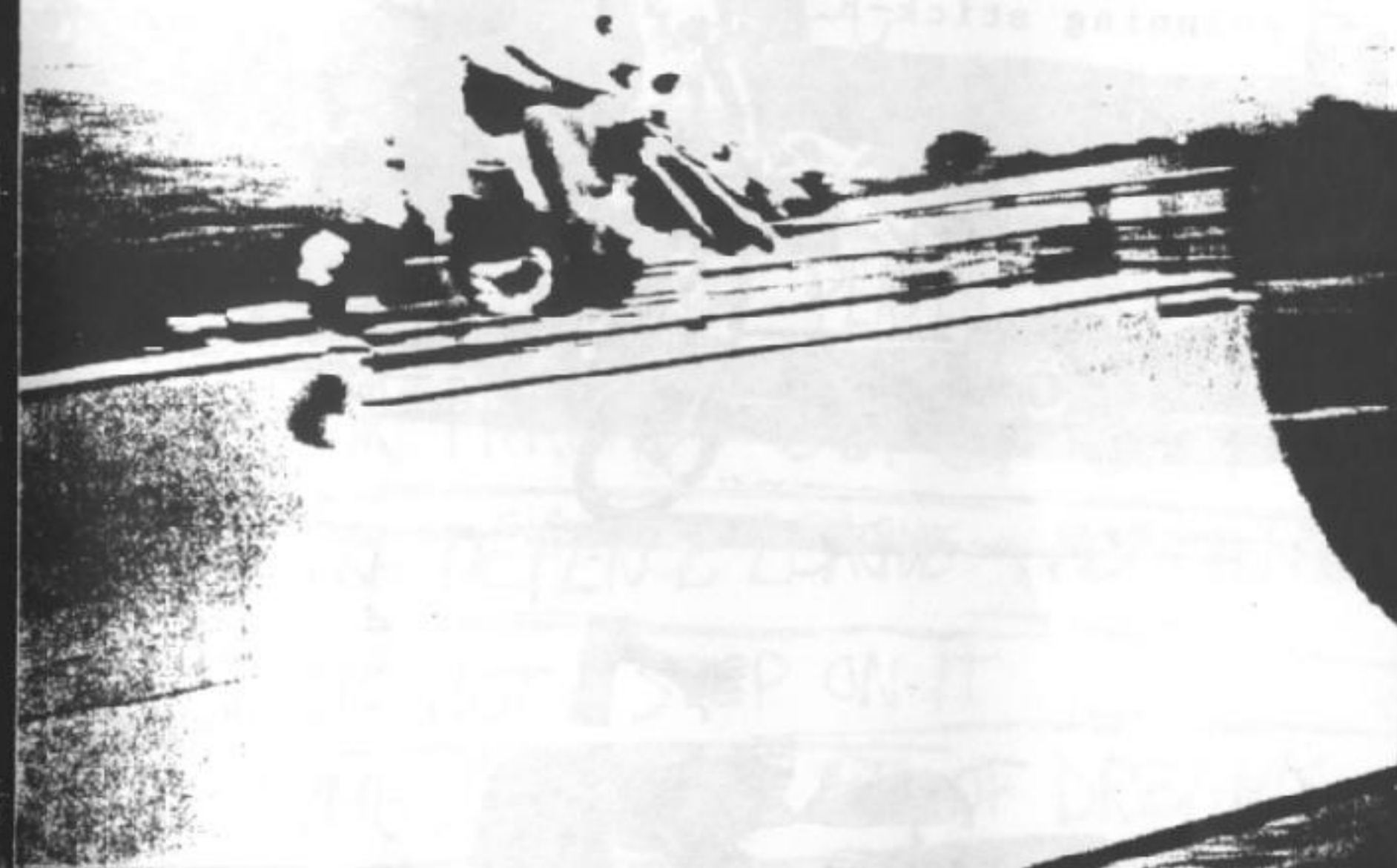

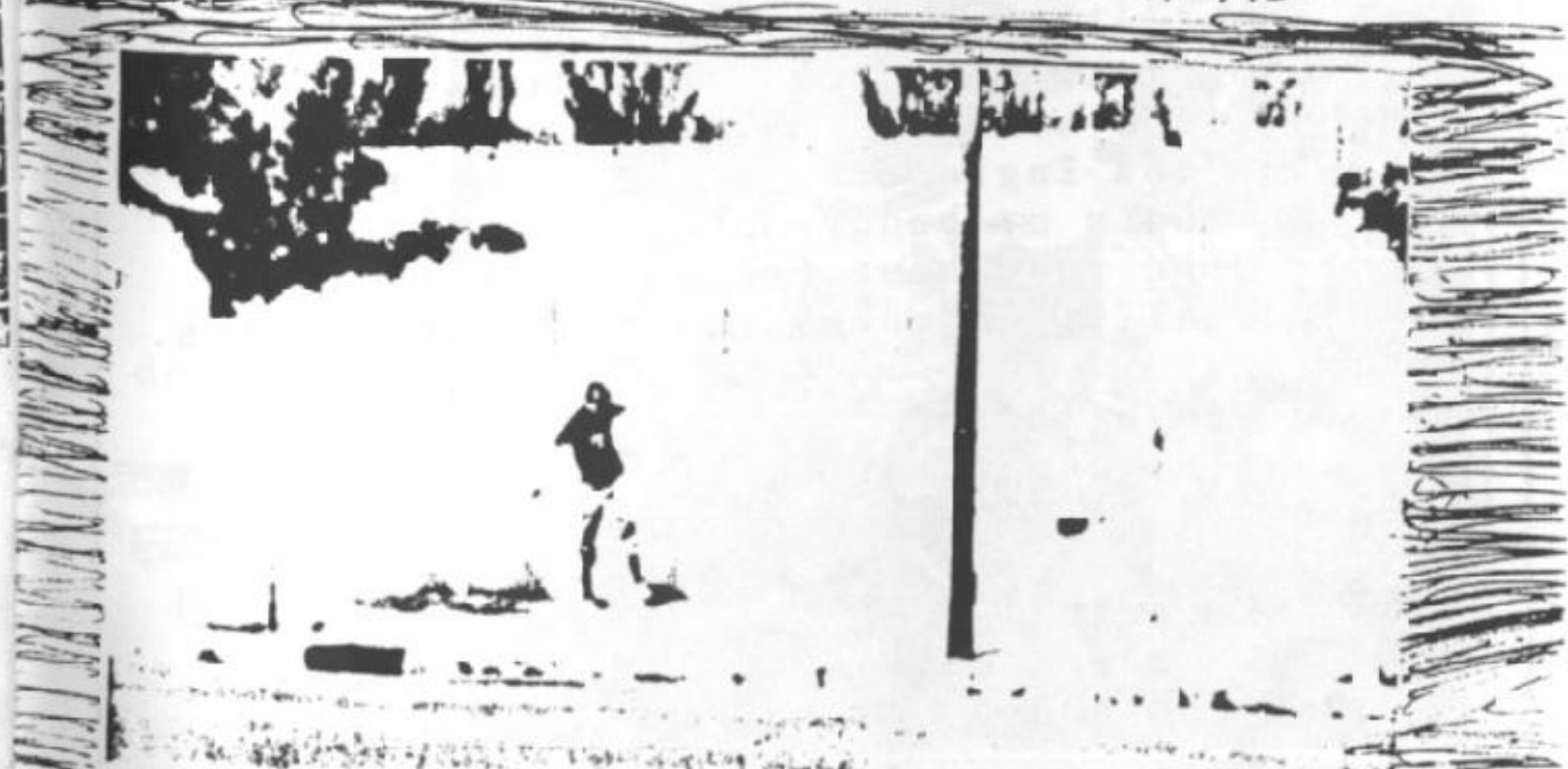
