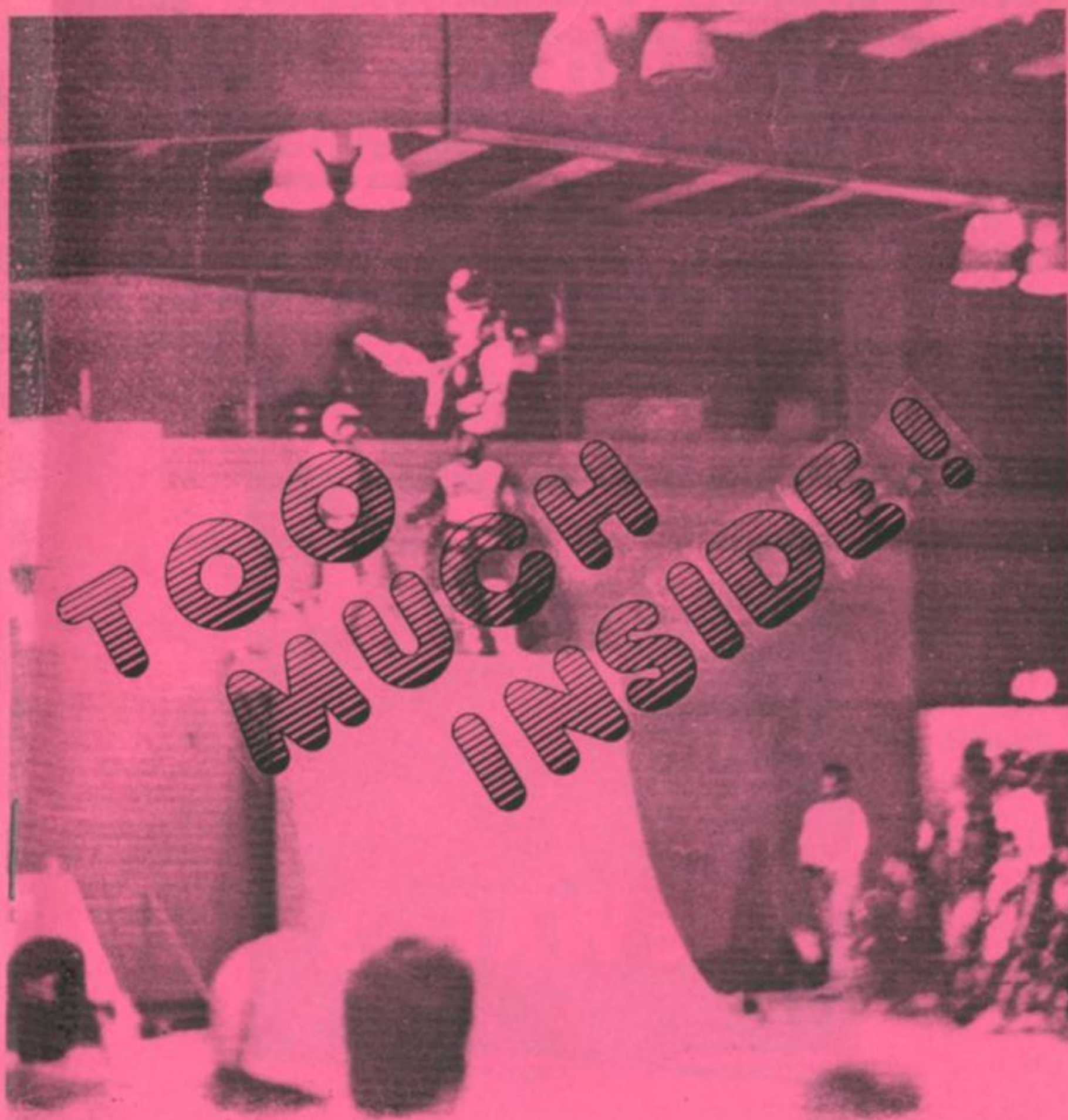

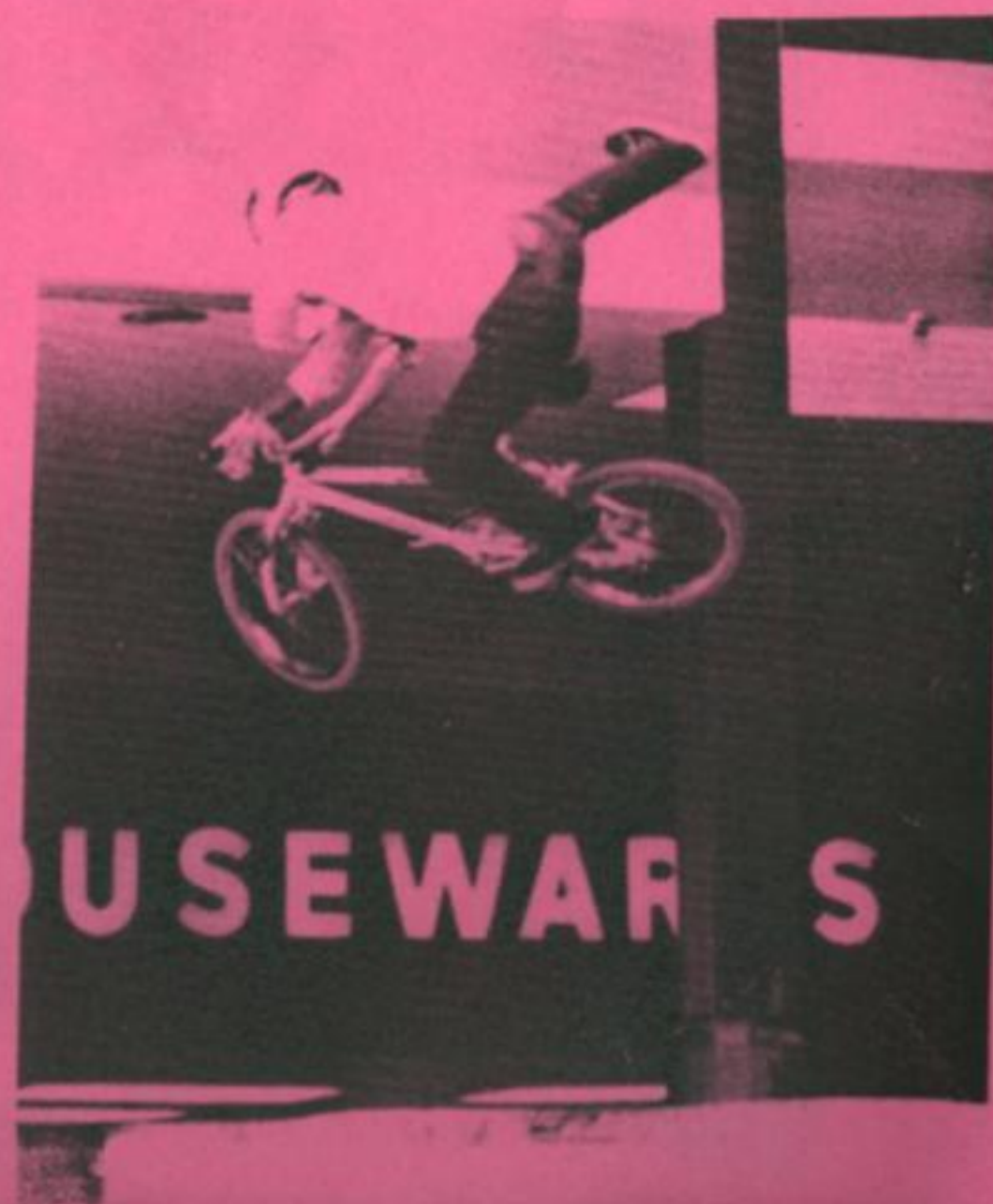


TOO MUCH INSIDE!

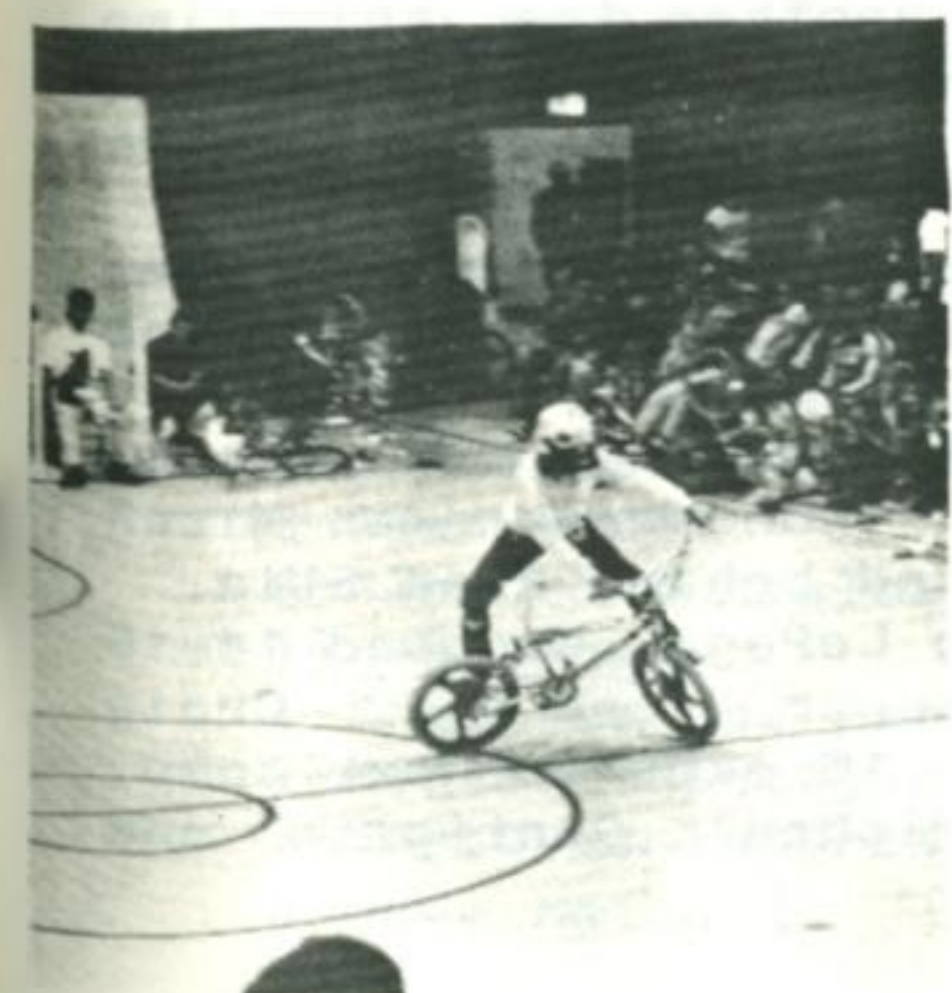
